Liz,

It's tough for me to me to speak on the misinformation coming from Camp 210. We hear a lot of conjecture and things said that sound fairly far fetched or untrue. We have been told that organizers have been coaching campers to not cooperate or communicate with first responders or service providers. I cannot specifically verify this, but it has come up multiple times. Also we hear some of the organizer's claims about services like Base Camp and HOT ignoring the campers. We have been told from both groups that they have experienced hostile and aggressive behavior when they did try and interact with the camp. We were told that, as a result, they have limited their interactions. This is similar to what our Patrol Officers have experienced on numerous occasions. Here is a list of the some of the incidents from Camp 210 that kind of demonstrate the mood and climate of the camp. Not sure how practical it would be for you to view, but the body cam footage from many of these incidents are pretty powerful and show the hostile environment our Officers have experienced when responding to the area.

Here are some significant calls from 210 Lottie. This does not account for all calls at that location or others that may have been associated with other nearby locations like the library lawn or surrounding streets.

We hope to name some specific safety concerns, so please let me know of any reports that you recommend we review or safety issues that you think we should address. For instance, Tara and I spoke to Hans after our call this morning and asked for specific examples to include about occurrences at Base

Camp, which we hope can provide a more tangible understanding of how things operate there.

Our goal is to build clear content that provides public information about the services available and some of the significant challenges associated with the encampment.
